



RULES FOR OXER FARM 2019 SERIES CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS

We are pleased to announce the rules for competitors in our 2019 Championship.

There are five (5) shows on our schedule this year. All are qualifiers for our Series Championship.

AWARDS

Champion and Reserve Champion rider/horse pairs will be awarded a ribbon and an award for Dressage and Combined Training Divisions. To qualify for Series Championship, riders must compete in four of our shows during the season.

Winners will be determined based on the calculation of the average of the four (4) best scores taken from any of our shows show during the season. All scores of qualifying riders will be reviewed and only the four (4) best will be averaged to determine the winning horse/rider pair in a division.

Dressage Awards: Riders must post scores at any four of the following qualifying shows: April 13, May 18, June 22, August 24, September 21. Awards will be given for the following Dressage divisions: Introductory, Training, First, Second and any higher level where a rider posts enough scores to qualify in that particular division. Dressage scores earned as part of a CT score will not count towards awards in any comparable dressage division.

Combined Training Awards: Riders must post scores at any four (4) of the following qualifying shows:
April 13, May 18, June 22, August 24, September 21
The combined dressage/stadium score for riders in the three-phase will be used to qualify those riders for CT championship awards. Awards will be given for the following divisions: Pre-Amoeba, Amoeba, Tadpole, Beginner Novice, Novice.
An Elimination in any over fences portion of the CT or Three Phase - Stadium or Cross Country, will disqualify the score.

Rider/horse pairs may compete in multiple levels during the season, but only the required number of scores posted at shows in any one division will count towards the year-end series championship.

Any rider/horse pair may earn Series awards in the same division for 3 consecutive years. At that point, they will no longer be eligible in that division but may earn a championship at the next level.

Our 2019 Series Championship awards will be presented in February, 2020 at the annual Lanier Equestrian Association awards banquet.
