

## UPDATED RULES FOR OXER FARM 2021 SERIES CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS

We are pleased to announce the rules for competitors in our 2021 Series Championship.

There are six (6) shows on our schedule this year. All are qualifiers for our Series Championship.

## AWARDS

Champion and Reserve Champion rider/horse pairs will be awarded a ribbon and an award for Dressage and Combined Training Divisions. To qualify for Series Championship, a rider/horse pair must compete in FIVE of our shows during the season. Awards are open to all riders with amateur status. In the event that both junior and adult amateur riders qualify in the same division, we will award both.

Winners will be determined based on the calculation of the average of the five (5) best scores taken from any of our shows show during the season. All scores of qualifying rider/horse pairs will be reviewed and only the five (5) best will be averaged to determine the winning horse/rider pair in a division.

Rider/horse pairs may compete in multiple levels during the season, but only the required number of scores posted in any one division will count towards the yearend series championship.

Any rider/horse pair may earn Series awards in the same division for 3 consecutive years. At that point, they will no longer be eligible in that division but may qualify to earn a championship at the next level.

## DRESSAGE

Rider/horse pairs must post scores at any FIVE of the following qualifying shows: *March 27, April 24, May 20, June 27, August 28, September 25.* 

Awards will be given for the following Dressage divisions: Introductory, Training, First, Second and any higher level where a rider posts enough scores to qualify in that particular division.

Dressage scores earned as part of a CT score will not count towards awards in any comparable dressage division.

## COMBINED TRAINING

Rider/horse pairs must post scores at any FIVE of the following qualifying shows: *March 27, April 24, May 20, June 27, August 28, September 25.* 

The combined dressage/stadium score for riders in the three-phase will be used to qualify those riders for CT championship awards.

Awards will be given for the following divisions: Pre-Amoeba, Amoeba, Tadpole, Beginner Novice, Novice.

An Elimination in any portion of the CT or Three Phase – Dressage, Stadium or Cross Country, will disqualify the score.

Our 2021 Series Championship award winners will be notified of their selection after the conclusion of our season in September and awards will be presented at a date to be determined.
